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

As the local congress organizer, it is my great pleasure to welcome you to Kaohsiung, Taiwan







### IOIS 2019 BenEzra Award

Dr Phuc LEHOANG, MD, PhD, is Honorary Professor of Ophthalmology at La Pitie-Salpetriere University Hospital, Sorbonne University, Paris (France). His ophthalmology residency in Paris was completed by a Master of Sciences in Biochemistry and an education at the Pasteur Institute leading to a degree of PhD in Immunology in 1979. He received his Doctor of Medicine degree at the Sorbonne University Medical School in 1981. He was appointed as Professor of Ophthalmology in 1985 and thereafter spent a sabbatical year as Visiting Scientist at the National Eye Institute (NIH, Bethesda, USA) where he had the privilege to work with Dr R.B. Nussenblatt, Dr F. Roberge, Dr R. Caspi and Dr C.C. Chan.

Dr LeHoang has co-authored over 300 articles in peer-reviewed literature as well as numerous book chapters and co-edited a textbook on Uveitis with Prof. Bahram Bodaghi. As an investigator on numerous projects dealing with research, medical and surgical management of ocular inflammation, he has established an effective school in that field.

He has participated in the organization of several international meetings, served as President of the International Ocular Inflammation Society from 2003 to 2011 (IOIS, founded by Prof. David BenEzra and Prof. Jorge Alio along with a group of 26 other ophthalmologists to which he belonged). With the help of his colleagues and friends from different continents,

Dr LeHoang gathered for the first time several major societies during the 2007 IOIS congress in Paris, thus starting a new era for scientific meetings devoted to ocular inflammation. Besides, he served as colonel (reserve) in the French army and received the Medal of Voluntary Military Services and the Medal of the National Defence. Member of the French National Academy of Surgery, he has been awarded knight in the Order of the Academic Palms (*Chevalier dans l'Ordre des Palmes Academiques*) and knight in the highest Order of the French Republic (Chevalier dans l'Ordre de la Legion d'Honneur).

### IOIS 2019 Gold Medal Award

Russell W Read MD PhD received his undergraduate degree in Pharmacy in 1988 from Auburn University, Auburn, Alabama, USA. Following two years of hospital pharmacy practice, he entered medical school at the University of Alabama at Birmingham, graduating Magna Cum Laude in 1994. He did an ophthalmology residency at the University of Washington in Seattle followed by dual fellowships in Uveitis/Ocular Inflammatory Diseases and Ophthalmic Pathology at the Doheny Eye Institute / University of Southern California under Professors Narsing A Rao and Ronald E Smith. In 2000 he joined the faculty of the University of Alabama at Birmingham and has risen through the academic ranks to his current position as the Max and Lorayne Cooper Endowed Professorship in Ophthalmology Residency Education, Professor of Ophthalmology and Pathology, effective October 2012. He focuses his practice exclusively on all forms of uveitis and ocular inflammatory diseases and serves as the only uveitis specialist in the State of Alabama, with a patient catchment area that includes not only Alabama but also large parts of Mississippi, Tennessee, and the Florida Panhandle.

Interested in the mechanisms of uveitis development, Dr Read earned a PhD in Immunology from UAB while executing an NIH/NEI Career Development Award (K08), studying the role of complement activation and inhibition on experimental autoimmune uveitis.

Dr Read is been involved in multiple uveitis organizations, being a member of the International Ocular Inflammation Society since 2001 and serving as the Scientific Program Chair for the 2017 and 2019 Congresses.

A member of the American Uveitis Society since 2000, Dr Read has served as Webmaster from 2001 to the present, during which time he created the AUS Discussion Group, a uveitis listserv for uveitis specialists to exchange ideas and discuss cases. Dr Read has served as the AUS Executive Secretary from 2007 to present.

Dedicated to education, he has served as the UAB Residency Program Director since 2008. Dr Read has participated in multiple American Academy of Ophthalmology activities since 1998, initially in multiple instruction courses and subsequently serving on a variety of committees, including the Uveitis Ophthalmic Knowledge Base / Practicing Ophthalmologists Curriculum Committee (member from 2003 to 2008, Vice-Chair from 2008 to 2013 and Chair from 2014 to the present); Uveitis Specialty Interest Topics Committee: Basic and Clinical Science Course, Section 9, Intraocular Inflammation and Uveitis Committee (member from 2009 to 2015, Chair from 2011 to 2015); as a speaker at the AAO Uveitis Subspecialty Day every offering, culminating as Chair for 2014 and 2016; as a panelist for the Uveitis Academy Cafè every year from 2012 to 2016; and as an instructor of the AAO Maintenance of Certification Review Course for the Uveitis Section in 2007 and from 2011 to 2016. He has served as the Councilor for the American Uveitis Society since 2016 and as Chair of the Council Credentials Committee for 2017. He has received the AAO's Secretariat Award twice, once in 2015 and again in 2019; the Senior Achievement Award in 2013 and the Achievement Award in 2006.


